5. Jaipur Art Week Transforms India's Famed "Pink City"

Often dubbed "The Pink City," the ancient Indian municipality of Jaipur has long been home to a treasure trove of architectural riches, buzzing bazaars, and a vibrant arts culture, harkening back to the Jaipur Exhibition of 1883. Now, arts patron Sana Rezwan, founder of the Public Arts Trust of India, is transforming the city once again for the third annual <u>Jaipur Art Week</u>, taking place from January 24-31. Featuring a host of site-specific installations, exhibitions, studios visits, and performances, the weeklong event will showcase the work of more nearly two dozen emerging and mid-career artists, among them Bhimanshu Pandel, who created a monumental public artwork with design firm Frozen Music. There will also be commissions at the elaborate Albert Hall Museum by Ellinor Euler, Wolf Jaipur and Ayushi Patni.
